## News and messages from around Pinvin



#### St Nicholas Church, Pinvin

Services: 10.30am on 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month

All are welcome at all services - do come along.

#### Dear Friends

Last month I wrote about the importance and place of St Nicholas Church in our village, and how we are facing some significant repairs which need to be carried out if St Nicholas is going to continue to stand and be available for the whole community. This month I want to share the details of some of the repairs.

We need to repair the rainwater goods, that's the drainpipes and gutters! These are essential for keeping rainwater away from the actual fabric of the church. In a domestic setting this is a big job, on a listed building it is even bigger. We have to use appropriate material for a heritage building, so the estimated cost for this repair is £15,000 -£18,000. There is also some work needed on the drainage channels, which will cost around £2.500.

We have some repairs to the roof, again to help keep the church watertight and dry. With the expertise and material needed it is estimated that this will cost £20,000-£25,000.

The bell cote is a distinctive feature of St Nicholas, and something that the children who visit get very excited about. They simply love to hear the bell being rung! Unfortunately, it needs repairing too, at an estimated cost of £10,000.

The other big repair that has been highlighted is the floor. Fortunately, we had a lovely new oak floor put in at the back of church some years ago, which is wearing well and looking great. The floor elsewhere in the church is not doing so well. Repairs are thought to cost £20,000-£25,000.

There are some other minor works that need attention but a look at the big items



shows that this is work that the PCC simply can't afford to do on its own. We really do need the help and financial support of the wider community. If you have fundraising skills and can help us with our fundraising campaign or just want to get involved in looking after the fabric of our church, please get in touch with either me or Glen Hurst. ## News and messages from around Pinvin

## **Worcestershire County Council**

#### Can you safely get about the village?

Over the next couple of weeks you will notice works going on to drop some curbs on Upton Snodsbury Road. We have a number of locations where it is hard for those in wheelchairs or mobility scooters to get around safely and we want to try and make the village as accessible as possible. If there are other areas you think need addressing, please get in contact so we can take a look.

I had a site meeting with members of the Highways team in February to discuss the pavements that need resurfacing (especially on Upton Snodsbury Road) and the mud build up at the crossings on the new Pinvin crossroads. These issues are now with the team and solutions are being drawn up.

I am also aware of the ongoing issues with traffic and parking during the school run. I am aiming to have an on site meeting with the local policing team in the coming weeks to see if we can look at solutions. The police have undertaken a number of speed checks within the 30mph zone in recent months and are now looking at safe spots to do the same within 40mph zones as well. I know a number of people have raised the idea of an average speed camera within the village. Currently there is a pilot scheme on the A449 between Worcester and Kidderminster but this region is yet to have any installed in rural areas like our own. This does make it harder to argue for a scheme but I plan to write to the Police and Crime Commissioner in the coming weeks to see if we could be considered for a pilot study. I hope to have an answer by the time of the next Pinpoint publication.
