
In September we will be hearing from Roger Workman all about Cotteswold Dairy which is one of the largest independent family dairies, founded by Roger's father, Harry, in 1938.

Bushes and shrubs

I've had many complaints about the summer green invasion we see on the roads, pavements and footpaths.

I am also finding the massive bush in my front garden is now trying to take over the footpath! The problem is always made worse by the sunny weather being broken by some downpours so June has been great for hedge growth.

If there are bushes and hedges in need of trimming, you can **report them to the county council** using the web address below. They will work with the landowners to get areas sorted and any that are county owned will be dealt with by the council.

Those of us who have hedges that face public spaces do have a legal responsibility to ensure they are kept clear of pavements and roads. If we can be patient with each other as we do the maintenance that would be great. Also, if someone is taking a little more time than we would like, it would be good if we can be kind to each other. We do not know what is happening in other people's lives and I am sure we are all doing our best. If people do need help, please get in touch and we will see if someone can offer some help.

Dear Friends.

They say it's a sign of age when time passes more quickly! I'm not sure what this says about me, but this year really does seem to have flown by so far! In the flurry of life and all its activity and busyness, as well as its quieter times, we sometimes need to take the opportunity to take stock and have a think about how we use the time given to us.

One of the Bible readings we use at funeral services is from the book of Ecclesiastes and includes the beautiful words, "For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven.... I know that whatever God does endures forever; nothing can be added to it, nor anything taken from it." The reading was made even more famous when The Byrds used it for their 1959 classic, *Turn! Turn! Turn!*

The reading, and the song, remind us that even if much of our time is managed by others, we still have the freedom to use much of the rest of our time in a way that we want. It's up to us whether we choose to have a hobby, or spend time with those we care about, or worship God, or walk in the beautiful place we live or sit down and be quiet. It's up to us whether we use our time trying to be loving and caring, or whether we use our time in less loving ways.

Time is a precious gift and how we use ours says so much about us and our priorities and passions. And if we believe that time is truly a gift from God, we will want to use it well. As the summer stretches out before us, perhaps this is a good time to have a look at how we use our time and see if we could make any changes to help us live not only contented lives, but lives that will also help us to better reflect God, who is beyond all time.

Wishing everyone a good summer holiday, however you use your time.

Our Church has a new **Architect**, and she has put forward a **list of work that needs to be done to the building fabric to keep it dry and safe.** An initial brief list in the order required is:- 1/ Water ingress at the roof joint between the Chancel and the Nave, 2/Bellcote and bell mechanism need repairs, 3/general roof repairs, 4/rain water gutters, and gullies. There are several more items. We will be looking for some financial help to cover the costs as we are not a wealthy church, so **if anyone in the village has experience of fund raising, please contact any of the PCC members**.

I am now stepping down as churchwarden, so please get in touch with John Kemp if you need someone to contact (see below). Finally all those going on holiday, in the next couple of months, look after each other, have a great time and stay safe.

Pinvin CE First School and


St Nicholas CE Middle School


